Safe Spring Riding

Be on the lookout for potholes and cracks in the road. Your motorcycle is much more susceptible to damage or loss of control if you hit one. If you can't avoid a pothole, slow down as much as safely possible to lessen the chance of loss of control or damage to your tires and wheels. Don't slam on your brakes, which can cause damage to your front-end suspension. Swerving to avoid a pothole can cause you to lose control of your bike – don't do it.

Gravel can also prove hazardous to motorcyclists due to loss of traction. Always avoid sudden braking or veering on gravel. Sudden acceleration can also cause you to lose control.

Road debris can spell trouble for motorcycle riders. Keep your eyes peeled on the road ahead to avoid hitting something that could cause an accident.
