THIS COULD HAPPEN IN THIS STATE

Illinois SB 2801 was introduced so that a person may not transport a child under 16 years of age as a passenger on a motorcycle, motor driven cycle, or motorized pedal cycle unless the child is wearing protective headgear and the chin strap is properly fastened; or the person is the child's parent or legal guardian and the person is carrying a Child Passenger Permit. Provides that a parent or legal guardian of a child under 16 years of age may apply to the Secretary of State for a Child Passenger Permit to allow the Child named in the Child Passenger Permit to be a passenger of THAT parent or legal guardian on a motorcycle without wearing protective headgear. The price of the permit is \$100.00 per child.

That means if you have 3 kids you have to get a PERMIT for each kid at \$100.00 each or say you and your wife both ride your own bike, both of you have to get a PERMIT for each kid.

OUCH!!!

Both the ABATE and the AMA do not like this bill.



SAFETY AND ED COORDINATOR

Hand signals for communicating while riding your motorcycle



- These signals will not cover every communication need, but they should fill in a lot of gaps.
 Remember, these signals must be seen to be understood.
- Acknowledge comprehension with a nod of the head or a flick of the dimmer switch. The rider
 in the rear can turn off or flick the headlight to attract the attention of the forward rider, the
 forward rider acknowledges with a nod or "come alongside" signal, then the rear rider makes a
 signal.
- These signals have been purposely kept left-handed to keep the right hand on the throttle/brake controls for safety's sake.
