Proposal for change:

If joins in the first 6 months (May 1 - Oct 31) of the Fiscal Year – new members pay full dues; and if they join in the final 6 months (Nov 1-Apr 31) – new members pay

#### 50% of the dues

If the new member is a 'returning' club member, they will pay the full years club dues, regardless of when they re-join.
