- II. - III. Motion to waive reading of last Month's Minutes. They were in the Newsletter Jim tried to put out. Jim Welcomed Larry back and everyone was glad to see him at the meeting. (Not just so he can do the Newsletter)
- IV. REPORT OF THE OFFICERS

Bill submitted a Receipt to Treasurer Jean Mumford for payment of the Web Site. It's about \$2.00 more a month (\$89.40 per year). We get unlimited storage and unlimited emails.

Treasurer Jean Mumford reported that we have \$595.78 and received \$200.00 in checks for membership renewal. We have 24 Paid members.

Secretary Jim Marsolais suggested that we tweak The Back Road Riders Constitution and By-Laws since in the last 11 years we've added Newsletter Editor and WEB Site Coordinator. We also discussed changing Event/Tour Director position to ROAD CAPTAINS and have the Road Captains coordinated by the Vice President. We have changed our Club Year (fiscal year) from September and plan to change it one month at a time every year, starting one month earlier until we get to May 1st as the beginning of the Club's fiscal year. We changed the Agenda slightly adding Call to order, Roll Call, Newsletter Editor, WEB Site and AMA sections. Some discussion followed and it was decided that Jim would type up some of the current changes and bring them to the next meeting and pass them out to the members (We can email them to members that can't make the meeting). If anyone has any additions, corrections or deletions we can review and post the changes and vote on a Revised Addition of our By-Laws in a few months.

Jim mentioned a few of the rides members went on last month and the fun they had on some of the gravel roads we found.
